The following is a copy of the letter that Bishop Hubbard sent today to the parishes in the Roman Catholic Diocese of Albany. At the bottom of the letter is information about how you can make a donation to provide help to the hurricane victims:

The devastation and destruction by Hurricane Katrina is being felt in many dioceses of the United States, but most especially in Louisiana, Mississippi and Alabama. The media coverage has made it abundantly clear that the needs will be great and long lasting. Further there is the possibility of more hurricanes coming in the next several months.

Millions of people are in need of assistance and Catholic Charities will be among the primary responders. Catholic Charities offices in the local dioceses have a professional and well-developed system of reviewing the needs and providing help where it can accomplish the most good. Catholic Charities will be providing emergency food, shelter, rent, medicine, utilities and mental heath counseling both for the short-term relief and long-term support during recovery efforts. Also, our Diocesan Catholic Charities office has offered to send volunteers to help directly in assisting the victims.

Given the enormity of the need in the wake of the hurricane devastation, I am asking you to take up a special collection this weekend for the relief efforts in the hurricane-affected areas of the United States.
